**Please be aware we have had to implement a number of changes to ensure we keep our swimmers and coaches safe.**

- Prior to attending every session, we ask that you complete a COVID-19 screening form, these will be emailed to you prior to our return on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup>, along with further session details and payment information.
- All swimmers must attend swim ready, wearing costume/trunks with suitable loose clothing over the top (we recommend onesie / dressing gown / joggers and sweatshirt).
- Registration for all sessions will take place at the main entrance.
- Swimmers aged 8yrs must be dropped off at the entrance, where they will be met by liaison officers.
- Swimmers under the age of 8 yrs. must be accompanied by a parent/carer. Accompanying adults will be allowed to spectate from the foyer area and are encouraged to wear a face covering whilst in the building.
- The liaison officers will escort all swimmers/parents/carers through the building to the pool area.
- Swimmers will be escorted to the balcony area where they will remove their top layer of clothing ready to swim. Clothing must then be placed in a bag which they can take with them onto poolside. Swimmers will then make their way directly to poolside, as directed by liaison officers and coaching staff.
- Liaison officers will observe the session to ensure that social distancing is maintained throughout.
- Following the session swimmers will dry off on poolside and put on their loose clothing over the top of their swimwear. Showers and changing rooms are not available at this time.
- Liaison officers will then escort swimmers out of the pool hall via the changing rooms to the main entrance where liaison officers will ensure they are collected by a parent/carer.

We are aware that a number of swimmers are in credit due to the cancelations at Brinscall pool in August. Further information will be sent out via email with regard to session payment.
